PREAMBLE

We, the members of AUGUSTINE AND ROSEMARYS INITIATIVE FOR YOUTH EMPOWERMENT a not for-profit and non-political organisation do firmly and solemnly resolve to provide for ourselves a constitution and to be governed by the provisions therein contained.

ARTICLE 1: NAME

The name of the Association is AUGUSTINE AND ROSEMARYS INITIATIVE FOR YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

ARTICLE 2: ADDRESS

The address of the Association shall be : 1, , UMUENEH, UMUNWE UMUABI, , ENUGU, ENUGU STATE, NIGERIA

ARTICLE 3: AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

SN	THE AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE ASSOCIATION ARE:
1	TO HELP YOUNG PEOPLE WITH THE RIGHT OPPORTUNITIES SO THEY CAN BUILD SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOODS.
2	TO PROVIDE DIGITAL AND VOCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES BY DISTRIBUTING ESSENTIAL HARDWARE AND TOOLS TO YOUTHS, INDIGENT STUDENTS AND SKILLED ARTISANS.

3	TO SETTLE AND DEFRAY MEDICAL EXPENSES AND TUITION FEES FOR VULNERABLE INDIVIDUALS, ENSURING THAT FINANCIAL BARRIERS DO NOT HINDER THEIR PROGRESS
4	TO COLLABORATE WITH INDIVIDUALS, GOVERNMENTS AND ORGANIZATIONS TO CREATE CSR-DRIVEN OPPORTUNITIES FOR COMMUNITY EMPOWERMENT.
5	TO ENLIGHTEN AND EVALUATE THE SOCIAL AND FINANCIAL IMPACT OF THE OPPORTUNITIES PROVIDED, ENSURING THEY LEAD TO GENUINE ECONOMIC AND NATIONAL GROWTH.
6	TO ENSURE A COMMUNITY PARTICIPATORY SELECTION PROCESS THAT IDENTIFIES AND REWARDS BENEFICIARIES BASED ON MERIT AND VERIFIED NEED.

ARTICLE 4: TRUSTEES

- A. The Trustees of AUGUSTINE AND ROSEMARYS INITIATIVE FOR YOUTH EMPOWERMENT for the purpose of the Companies and Allied Matters Act CAP C20 LFN 2004, shall be elected at a General Meeting charged with responsibility of selecting the Trustees with 2/3 majority votes of members present.
- B. Such Trustees (Hereinafter referred to as, “The Trustees”) shall not be less than 2 and more than 15 in number.
- C. A Trustee may hold office for 5 years but shall cease to hold office if he:
1. Resigns his office
 2. Ceases to be a member of the registered Trustees of the body.
 3. Becomes insane
 4. Is officially declared bankrupt
 5. Is convicted of a criminal offence involving dishonesty by a Court of competent jurisdiction
 6. Is recommended for removal from office by a board of Governors and Trustees majority vote of members present at any General Meeting of the body
 7. Ceases to reside in Nigeria
- D. Upon a vacancy occurring in the number of Trustees a General Meeting will be held to appoint another eligible member of the Association.

ARTICLE 5: COMMON SEAL

- A. The Trustees shall have a Common seal.



B. Such seal will be kept in the custody of the SECRETARY who shall produce it when required for use by the Trustees.

C. All documents to be executed by the Trustees shall be signed by such number of them and sealed with the Common seal.

ARTICLE 6: MEETINGS

For effective administration of the Association, there shall be the following meetings

ARTICLE 7: GOVERNING BODY

(1) THE GOVERNING COUNCIL (2) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES (3) THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

ARTICLE 8: SOURCES OF INCOME

The sources of income for the Association shall include:

1. ACCEPT DONATIONS (WHETHER CASH AND/OR KIND) FROM INDIVIDUALS, CORPORATE BODIES, ORGANIZATION IN NIGERIA OR ELSEWHERE
2. RECEIVE GRANTS OR ASSISTANCE FROM INDIVIDUALS, TRUSTS FUND AND OTHER CHARITABLE OR PHILANTHROPIC ORGANIZATIONS IN NIGERIA OR ELSEWHERE

ARTICLE 9: DISBURSEMENT AND APPLICATION OF FUNDS

THAT THE FUNDS BE USED FOR THE AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE FOUNDATION

ARTICLE 10: KEEPING ACCOUNT

THE TRUSTEES SHALL OPEN AN ACCOUNT OR ACCOUNTS IN ANY REPUTABLE BANK OR BANKS AND THE SIGNATORIES TO THE ACCOUNTS(S) SHALL BE THE CHAIRMAN PROVIDED ANY TWO OF THE SIGNATORIES SHALL BE SUFFICIENT FOR WITHDRAWAL FROM THE ACCOUNT AT ANY GIVEN TIME. THE TRUSTEES SHALL ENSURE THE ACCURATE KEEPING OF ALL INCOME AND EXPENDITURE.

ARTICLE 11: APPOINTMENT OF AUDITOR(S)

1. Independent qualified and licenced Auditors shall be appointed by the general meeting to audit the financial records of the Association annually and submit an audited report to the Annual General Meeting of the Association.
2. The audited financial statements (balance sheet and income and expenditure account) duly certified by independent auditors shall be annexed to the annual returns and file with the Corporate Affairs Commission.

ARTICLE 12: AMENDMENT OF CONSTITUTION

The Association may alter the provision of its Constitution at a General meeting by a resolution passed by a simple majority of its members and approved by the Commission.

ARTICLE 13: SPECIAL CLAUSE

1. THE INCOME AND PROPERTY OF AUGUSTINE AND ROSEMARYS INITIATIVE FOR YOUTH EMPOWERMENT shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objective of the body as set forth in this RULES AND REGULATION/CONSTITUTION: and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise howsoever by way of profit, to the members of the Association.
2. PROVIDED that nothing herein shall prevent the payment in good faith, or reasonable and proper remuneration to any officer or servant of the Association in return for any service actually rendered to the Association:
 - a. With the exception of ex-officio members of the Governing Council, no member of the Council of Management or Governing Body shall be appointed to any salaried office of the Association or any office of the Association paid by fees; and
 - b. No remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the body to any member of such Council or Governing Body except repayment of out of pocket expenses or reasonable and proper rent for premises demised, or let to the Association or reasonable fees for services rendered.
3. If in the event of a liquidation/winding-up or dissolution of the corporate body there remains after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Association but shall be given or transferred to some other institutions, having object similar to the object of Association, such institutions to be determined by the members of the Association at or before the time of dissolution.
4. If effect cannot be given to the aforesaid provisions, then the remaining property shall be transferred to some charitable object.
